





5 years and counting...

A small group of thoughtful young people working together towards changing the world into a better place was how **THUVAKKAM** was started. It was in the year 2014 when a group of like-minded youngsters gathered to talk about society. Not too long in the discussion, they realized that each and every one of them were a part of the society which they were blaming. It was each and everyone's duty to do their part in creating a better society as much as it is the part of others. This thought inside them sowed the seeds of Thuvakkam.

Started out as a pet project, the team started exploring social issues. Their first initiative was a tree plantation at their very own college. Knowing they wanted to do more, the team registered itself as non-governmental organization named; 'THUVAKKAM', which implies a beginning in Tamil. They wanted to be the beginning of change and solely believed that this change can be brought into the society only by being the change that one wishes to see in this society.



With the commencement of the organization, the team started taking up various social causes primarily involving environment and education. From tree plantation, clean up initiatives and orphanage visits the team consistently started looking upon innovative ways to touch the humanity in everyone's life. That was when they created one of their innovative projects called 'Clean-up after dark (CAD)' where the volunteers gather in a public place at night; cleaned, painted and renovated the place. The idea behind this was, if a place is already clean when a person comes in, they don't dirty it.











With innovative ideas to impact people, foster change and better the society the THUVAKKAM team started expanding into new ventures and projects. Initiatives such as back-a-thon, modern thandora, karka kasadara, plant a sapling, book for a cause, seed ball making, online campaigns, back2box challenges and nature walks were few of such initiatives that the organization took up. In next to no time, the team multiplied in size, network and within a blink of an eye there were 5 major sustainable change initiatives.



PASUMAI THUVAKKAM

The green cover of the planet Earth has reduced dramatically due to rapid industrialization and growing urbanization. For a calls country that proudly Agriculture the backbone of its economy, India needs to set a higher standard for the sustainable development future generations.

Thuvakkam has always considered the plantation and protection of plants as the key to overcoming global warming and pollution. With this in mind, Thuvakkam has always dedicated resources to the planting of more saplings, and periodic care of the plants as they grow to become trees and fulfill their purpose.



Thuvakkam has launched numerous projects under the banner of Pasumai Thuvakkam. With each new project, Thuvakkam has strived to reach a versatile crowd of people to inculcate the habit of planting and taking care of trees. The first project was titled 'Gift a Sapling', which enabled people to gift plant saplings to each other, that Thuvakkam members hand delivered.

In order to capture the attention of kids and get them inculcated into this habit, Thuvakkam introduced a crafty new venture with **Seedball making**. Seedballs have been used globally to disperse seeds over a large area for afforestation. This was conducted in two phases. As part of summer activities, kids were invited to take part in seedbal making, by handcrafting a few seeds encased in mud balls that can be used for planting. Then they were scattered on barren lands that showed potential. This enabled mass plantation within a short period of time.

Thuvakkam has always valued the propogation of plants that have their natural home in Tamilnadu. After learning about a Japenese method with the same intentions, Thuvakkam launched 'Miyawaki Afforestation'. Miyawaki method involves planting saplings that are regional, as they have an inbuilt capability to survive in the climate. This year, Thuvakkam has taken it a step further to intriduce plants into the city, with the 'Urban Forestry' project.



CLEANUP AFTER DARK

There are so many places in the city that people walk by every day without even realizing the steady dirt that accumulates over time. If only care had been taken at the start, those places would not have become untidy. Trash begets trash and people forgo upkeep for easiness. Bus stops, schools, long stretches of walls covered in movie posters and ads, how can they be reclaimed?






This core idea inspired Thuvakkam to launch "Cleanup After Dark". With the hustle and business of city life, public areas cannot be cleaned in the day without causing hindrance to the public. But what if it is done at night?

A team of members and volunteers pick a spot, like a bus stop, Care homes or government schools, and work on it through the night. The walls are cleaned to remove posters and dirt, before a base layer of color is applied. Volunteers then set out to paint it with pictures, inspirational quotes and messages to attract people walking by it to take notice. If a place is clean, people will not tarnish it. This is the motto of the Cleanup after Dark project.

This project has steadily grown in scale, inviting people of all ages, even little kids who just want to paint. This was taken to a grander scale when Thuvakkam organized a massive 36-hour Cleanathon of Valluvar Kottam and its surrounding walls.





KARKA KASADARA

"Education is the most powerful tool you can equip yourself with." And this education extends beyond the classrooms and corridors of a school. Real education is found outside the pages of a book and earned outside the marks on a paper.



With this fundamental notion, Thuvakkam started the "Karka Kasadara" project to teach burgeoning kids the practical realities of life. Working together with a mentor, Dr. Sultan Ismail, members crafted a syllabus that covers a wide range of topics.

Classes are scheduled in the week where students of all ages take part in interactive sessions with educators well-versed in the topics. No question is beyond limits, no doubt unanswered. Volunteers also perform simple scientific experiments to keep the kids entertained while getting them enthused about science and mysteries of the world.

These classes cover important topics for a child's life, such as 'Basic Computer skills', 'Arasiyal Pazhaghu', 'Ariviyal Aayiram' and 'Naan yaar'. These are tailored to help them understand themselves, the political hierarchy that society lives by, the science behind the world and the technology that is becoming prevalent everywhere. Students are enthused with these classes as they provide an open forum to clarify their doubts that they might otherwise internalize.

And one other additional project that is key to Karka Kasadara is 'Sponsor for Success.' Through donations from volunteers, students are carefullt vetted before Thuvakkam provides funds for their educational purposes. With each kid that gets an education, the world becomes a better place to live.





MODERN THANDORA

In ancient times, without the prevalent tools of social media or news organizations, there was one artform that stood out when it came to capturing the audience's attention and convey information. When it came to raising awareness and educating the people, Thuvakkam looked the old and proven ways of street performance. Thuvakkam launched the project titled 'Modern Thandora', in order to perform mimes and street plays to playfully and meaningfully carry an idea to the people's minds.





When it can to public perception, holding placards or talking about serious issues might influence the public for a day, by the end of which they forget it. Seeing and experiencing the issues on the other hand, would stay with them forever.

Thuvakkam has a dedicated team of members and volunteers who work together to perfect the art of miming. With rigorous practice, they have trained to express emotions through their face and muscles to convey to the audience pain, pity and playfulness that the audience remembers. Through Modern Thandora, Thuvakkam has tackled various issues of the society, from sexual harassment, plastic awareness, environmental preservation and much more.

These street plays and mimes proved to be so effective, that Thuvakkam teamed up with the Income Tax comission to raise awareness about the harmful effects of Bribery as part of their Income Tax awareness week.

In order to grab the audience's attention, volunteers perform a 'Flash Mob' in the midle of the street to ensure the audience stays entertained, while also consuming a good moral message that they can remember in the context of their day to day lives. Modern Thandora is thenew generation take on mass messaging in the physical world, rather than the digital.





NEWER INITIATIVES

With the changing times and the changing needs of the people, Thuvakkam needs to come up with ideas that produce lasting impact on the society while encouraging others to do the same. This is a collaborative effort, in which raising awareness and creating a call for action is just as important as raising the issue and planning the activity. This has always driven Thuvakkam to come up with new ideas, from Cleanup After Dark, to Backathon and much more.

With every year, Thuvakkam has a new mechanic that affects a different problem that is seen in the society. Her are some of the ventures that are in their burgeoning stages.



KURAL

With every event and activity, Thuvakkam has focused on one aspect. But this changed with the initiative of Kural, a monthly newsletter that is crafted by the volunteers. From the articles to the design and publication, every little detail is thought of and analyzed by members who help create it.

Kural has been a key to understanding the pulse of the nation. Every issues of the magazine tackles what is foremost on the mind of the citizens. From moments of pride such as Sports or Rocket science, to the dark underbelly of Child Abuse or domestic violence. Every article is carefully written to provide the most unbiased information on the topic, that informs its readers of the issue.








EVERY EVENT COUNTS...






GROWING IN STRENGTH

Thuvakkam started its journey with the very first plantation event held at the college of its founders. With the pure intention of doing good, Thuvakkam comprised of students and classmates who came together to toil in the sun to plant numerous saplings on a field.

That passion and hardwork ensured Thuvakkam stayed strong from the very first day of starting work. Pretty soon, volunteers became members, future leaders, and the founding principles of Thuvakkam took shape.

Thuvakkam registered officially under the government as an NGO.

FUELING THE DREAM

With the monumental task of creating a better society, Thuvakkam set out to make changes with every activity and event. These projects are possible only by donors and their donations. In 2019, Thuvakkam secured Form 80G status, which enables funds recieved as donations to be exempt from taxation. This enables the debitor to save a little themselves, while their contribution does good for their surroundings.

In the FY2018, Thuvakkam recieved a total amount of Rs.21,58,118
