

In the past month, Thuvakkam organised and executed fourteen events which incorporated three on-field and eleven virtual events. Three articles were also released in the Kural blog under the title "A Day to make the impossible-possible", "How a 17-year-old raised 2 Lakhs for the education of others" and "Self Discipline". All these events were executed in a way that it complements the main motto of Thuvakkam "Be the change you wish to see in the world".







Spotlight of the Month



Eco Week 2021 Thuvakkam celebrates the week around World Environment Day (WED), observed on Jun. 5th, as Eco Week. First started in 2016, Eco Week activities and events are structured to raise awareness about the environment, sticking to the theme fixed by the United Nations (UN). This year's theme for the WED was "Restoration", which formed the unifying link between all of Thuvakkam's Virtual Eco Week events.

The Eco Week started with a unique session taken by S.R.Ganesh from Snake Park, highlighting the importance of reptiles in an ecosystem. The following day built upon these concepts, with professor Antony Stephen of Madras School of Social Work (MSSW) explaining Social Entrepreneurship in the context of altruistic work. Participants learnt about the moral and economic viability of entering the field of social work. There was also a lively panel discussion held with industry experts. It involved Dr. V.R.Manoj, the head of Biotechnology from Veltech Institute of Science and Technology, Prof. Ahit Seshadri of Vels University's School of Maritime Studies, and Mr. Manikandan of "Kovai Kulangal Padhukappu Amaippu". The participants of Eco Week were then taken on a Virtual Eco Tour from the comfort of their home. Covering various biomes and habitats from all over the world, the 360° video tour engaged tourists with amazing visuals and stark facts. The Eco week then culminated with a practical "Do it yourself" Bird Feeder session where volunteers learnt about Birds and their roles in the environment, and how to make a simple bird feeder with household materials.

The 5th iteration of Thuvakkam's Eco Week followed the fully virtual approach due to Covid constraints. But the feedback and enthusiasm of volunteers remained the same. Thuvakkam also honored some of these volunteers who have worked with dedication in Thuvakkam's Environment projects. Dubbing them "Eco Warriors", volunteers were thanked during Eco Week for their Eco efforts.

This Eco week is yet another step in the right direction for raising awareness about the Environment, and enacting steps in preserving it.
